His passion for art ignited when 9-year-old Nuriman won first prize in an art competition held by the National Museum Malaysia. He has held many solo and group exhibitions. Nuriman works across a variety of media. He paints, sculpts, creates art installations. Nuriman is interested in articulating the dialogue between technique and the materials he works with.

Nuriman has also taught art since 2009 based on his own personally devised curriculum. Although he works with any age group and national, his primary interest is teaching and inspiring children with art. He has worked with refugee children from Myanmar, Syria, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Indonesia through the Dignity for Children Foundation. Nuriman sees art as a guide and a journey towards discovery of our inner aesthetic selves. He believes all of us have that power if only we nurtured it well.
